



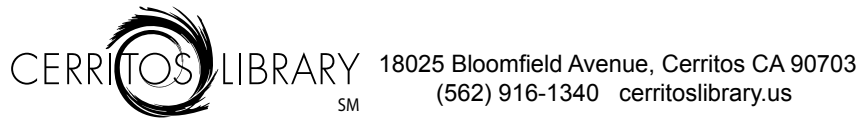
Contests for Talented Teens
